# PRESTO Autonomous Shuttles

*It's go time.*

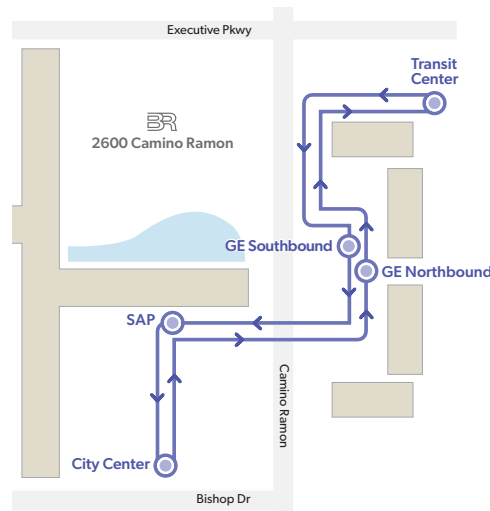
The Contra Costa Transportation Authority (CCTA) is running low-speed, autonomous shuttles at Bishop Ranch, a business park in San Ramon, California. Named PRESTO, the shuttles at Bishop Ranch are part of a series of shared autonomous vehicle (SAV) pilot projects that will lay the groundwork for improving mobility options for all, including transportation-challenged and underserved communities. The program will run shuttles from April 24, 2023 to Fall 2023.

## How to Ride

1. Find your closest shuttle stop. The shuttles arrive every 20-25 minutes.
2. Wait for the vehicle to stop and the doors will open automatically.
3. Buckle up and enjoy the ride.
4. Scan the QR code inside the PRESTO shuttle to let us know what you think about your ride!

## Quick Facts

The shuttle is free and open to the public!

PRESTO shuttles hold a maximum of 8 passengers plus an attendant.

PRESTO shuttles have a maximum speed of 15 miles per hour.

PRESTO shuttles don't have drivers, pedals, or a steering wheel but will have an on-board attendant to monitor safety.

The autonomous shuttle operator, Beep, will remotely and continuously monitor the shuttles while in operation.

Riders age 16 and under must be accompanied by an adult.
