BRite Bikes FREE bike share program is the quick, convenient, and healthy way to travel around Bishop Ranch. Make exercise a priority with a ride to explore Roundhouse restaurants, City Center, or the Shops.



How to:

Register

- Download the HOPR Transit App
- Register your account
- Select "Free Annual Pass" in the menu

Ride

- Scan the bike locks QR code; or enter 4-digit number on fender to unlock
- Perform a safety check: saddle, breaks, tires
- Enjoy your ride!

Return

- Park at a designated rack
- Secure with the cable
- Depress the lever to lock and end session

Guidelines

- Abide traffic laws, signals and signs.
- Stay on the right side of the road
- Use hand signals when turning
- Wear a helmet
- Yield to pedestrians in crosswalks

Getting Around:

App Download: HOPR Transit Available in the Google Play / Apple App Store.

Cost: FREE! A valid credit card is required to activate the account. Charges are only incurred for lost property and damages.

Equipment: 7 speed pedal bikes with baskets, locks and adjustable seats.

Locations: Bikes are available at all Bishop Ranch properties. Don't see a bike nearby? Let us know by emailing hello@gohopr.com and we'll roll into a bike rack near you!

Restrictions: Bikes must be returned to a designated hub within 24 hours of rental. Bikes removed from Bishop Ranch property will have a \$25 daily assessment charged, up to \$300.



Bike Shop

The Bike Shop at BR2600 is a secure facility featuring racks, lockers, a bicycle repair stand, tools and tire pump, and a parts vending machine.

Bike Shop Basics

Shop Entry: Property entrance through the gate from Bishop Drive. Building access at far right outer door of Roundhouse Fitness. Key card required.

Hours: Open 5:30 a.m. - 8:30 p.m. Monday through Friday, aligned with Roundhouse Fitness. No weekend access.

Racks: Single and double decker racks are available for most bikes. E-bike charging is not provided. Riders provide their own locks.

Lockers: There are no locker reservations or fees. Day lockers are first come, first served. Riders must provide their own lock.

Tools and Parts: A bike repair rack and basic tools such as an air pump, wrenches, and vending for tubes, etc. are provided.

Showers: The shop is proximal to the Fitness Center where cyclists get reduced cost member access to shower facilities.



Request Access: In the tenant hub, select Bikes and complete the application. All applicants must register each bicycle with the San Ramon Police Department, a complimentary service from BRTC.
