

BR EV Charging Stations

Electric vehicle charging infrastructures are available throughout Bishop Ranch on the EV Connect Networks. Bishop Ranch 1, Bishop Ranch 3, and Bishop Ranch 15 all offer public level 2 EV Charging.



EV Connect Network

Bishop Ranch uses the EV Connect network, giving drivers fast access to over 150 level 2 charging stations. Your account lets you pay securely and provides 24/7 customer support. EV Connect chargers are located at Bishop Ranch 1, 3, 15.

Wevo Energy Network

Two Wevo chargers are available at 6101 Bollinger Canyon Road (BR1). Chargers are accessible through the Wevo Energy app. Further app instructions are listed below.

ChargePoint at BR3

BR3100 Parking Garage

Tenants in the South and East wings of BR2600 have exclusive access to a limited number of Level 1 chargers on the first floor of the parking garage. Garage access is key card controlled and chargers are available on a first come, first served basis.

Getting Connected:

EV Connect

1. Download the free EV Connect app.
2. Login or register to create an account.
3. Select "Charge and scan the QR code located at the connector.
4. Plug in your vehicle and select "Begin Charge."
5. When charging is complete, end your session and unplug the connector

Wevo Energy App

1. Use [this link](#) to self-sign up for a Wevo Account.
2. Download Wevo Energy app and log in with the temporary password.
3. Plug in your vehicle. Select the charger you are using from the map (click pin icon and select charger).
4. Scroll to the bottom, and press "Start Charging."
5. When done charging, unplug, or hit "Stop Charging" in the app.

Guidelines:

- Be courteous to your colleagues, relocate your vehicle from the connector when done charging. "Parking" may incur penalty fees.
